
UNIVERSITY COMMUNICATIONS (UCOMM)








Colvard, 4th Floor EXISTING



JAMIL NINER PANTRY



Our mission at the Jamil Niner Student Pantry is to ensure food security, human dignity, and well-being on campus by providing in-need UNC Charlotte students with healthy, culturally appropriate emergency food.

- 1. To serve students' food insecurity needs.
- 2. To raise awareness and to educate the campus as well as the community about food insecurity.
- 3. To provide an on-campus site for service learning.



JAMIL NINER PANTRY

124 John Kirk (house) was allocated for use as the Niner Pantry in 2015 for 2 years

- The pantry provides assistance to UNC Charlotte undergraduate and graduate students who struggle with food insecurity.
- The Pantry operates Monday, Wednesday & Thursday from 2-5 pm
- Student volunteers are supervised by UNC Charlotte staff at all times.

The UNC Charlotte Endowment has agreed to extend the MOU for an additional two calendar years (2021 & 2022).

A Memorandum of Understanding has been completed
