INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES

The mission of Student Assistance and Support Services (SASS) is to assist, support and advocate for students experiencing a broad range of issues, concerns or challenges interfering with a student's ability to be successful academically or personally.

Requesting to relocate from King suite 118, 205 & 206 to Cone suite 349 (1,423 sf):

- Current staff (5) professional staff members, (1) admin support
- King suite 118 does not allow for accommodating additional personnel
- (2) New hires (shown in current staff) Assistant Director for Case Management & Assistant Director Case Financial Wellness – 2 additional offices in Cone suite 349 can accommodate new hires
- Hiring of a graduate assistance currently on hold no space for them to meet with students in private – propose room 349E (239 sf) for GA's
- Request that conference room 348C (238 sf) be allocated to Cone University Center for shared, scheduled use.
- Only renovation work would be for a new door from the existing office suite to the main corridor, Student Affairs would fund.



JAMIL NINER PANTRY


124 John Kirk (house) was allocated for use as the Niner Pantry in 2015 for 2 years

- The pantry provides assistance to UNC Charlotte undergraduate and graduate students who struggle with food insecurity.
