**1. Space Requests for Review and Approval –**


- Covid 19 related - Temporary (through 6/2021):



### Covid 19 Testing Lab – Cameron 2<sup>nd</sup> floor




McEniry HVAC Project Temporary Moves (through 12/2021):





Academic Affairs requests use of room 113C (120 sf), currently unassigned, for temporary office supplies storage (1 year duration). Urban Institute’s move from Colvard, 1<sup>st</sup> floor to Sycamore is currently underway. The storage closet in the office suite in Sycamore cannot accommodate all of the office supplies the department currently has on hand, acquired over time in Colvard and therefore are requesting the room in CAB for one year during which time other arrangements can be made.
