1. Is there a Pre-Proposal Meeting sign in sheet?

2. Are we allowed to use the UNCC logo in our submission?

PDF floor plans and AutoCad drawing files are available for most of the UNC Charlotte athletic facilities. These are typically the original design documents and do not reflect subsequent renovation improvements. Documents, including drawings, for subsequent renovations may be available. Drawings and other building information will be provided to the selected consultant.

4. Is an equipment listing and retirement schedule available for the equipment housed within the existing athletic facilities?

A list of equipment, age and condition is available for some buildings. The information may not be complete or up-to-date. This information will be provided to the selected consultant.

5. Has the university identified individuals who will be the key stakeholders?

The executive/steering committee members and other key stakeholders will be identified by the university prior to the start of the project.

6. Has UNCC completed any benchmarking in comparison to other schools, either within the conference or region? We presume this will be part of the project scope, please confirm.
