1. Can you confirm the schedule for the project?

The section under SCHEDULE in the RFP should read as follows:

"The designer must be able to complete all requirements of the contract and complete the Advance Planning for this project prior to November 22, 2012 in accordance with the planned start of construction on December 1, 2013."
