o Renovation of five (5) existing 2-story buildings over a 2-year, phased schedule.

- o PHASE 1: December 2016- July 2017 DENNY (34,000 sf),
- o PHASE 2: July 2017- April 2018 Macy & Barnard (18,000 sf each),
- o PHASE 3: June 2018-December 2018- Garinger & Winningham (18,000 sf each)

GENERAL CONTRACT INFORMATION

- This project is CM @ Risk which promotes teamwork, prequalification of subs, minimize change orders, flexibility, open book, and communication.
- BCC's goal for HUB participation is 30%
- UNC Charlotte guidelines are to provide everyone equal opportunity
- Prequalification forms will list out which bid packages will not require bonds. 85% do not require bonds. During the meeting BCC did not distribute prequalification forms to the

- attendees because of a revision that was needed. BCC will email the prequalification form out along with the meeting minutes and presentation after the meeting.
- BCC stressed the importance of understanding which affidavits to submit with your bid. If you
 are contemplating using Affidavit B, please call Danny Staton (704-408-9677) to discuss. There
 are very few bid packages that qualify to use Affidavit B and this needs to be discussed with
 Danny prior to submitting.

Questions:

- When will drawings and Specs be available?
 - The 100% CD's have been submitted to the State Construction Office (SCO) and comments have been received. The design team is currently reviewing the comments and finishing the For Construction documents. We anticipate having these drawings ready by the end of July.
- Where is available parking?
 - Starlight Movie Theatre across the street from campus has an overflow parking lot. All
 vehicles have to obtain a free parking permit to use this lot. Then each trade is required
 to shuttle their workers from this lot to the jobsite. No vehicles are allowed on site.
 Make sure all deliveries are being scheduled.
 - Comments from Dorothy Vick Hub Coordinator for UNC Charlotte If you get a parking ticket on campus, UNC Charlotte cannot help you. Parking permits are free and they must be displayed at all times on the vehicle it is registered with. Building will be empty when you start & there are about 5900 students living on campus.
