Repairs to Electrical, Plumbing, HVAC – McEniry (Electrical Package – Phase 1)

The scope of the project is to replace an existing generator that feeds the McEniry building and McMillian Greenhouse. To limit downtime, the new equipment will be set and made operational, the loads will be moved over one by one, and then the existing equipment will be demolished. The project is divided into multiple phases and all outages will be closely coordinated with the University. The scope of the project is primarily exterior work. The equipment to be demolished includes a boiler and associatedbuilding, a generator and associated building, a standalone generator, panelboards, and various feeders, boxes, and circuitry. The new equipment includes a generator, a generator docking station, automatic transfer switches, panelboards, concrete-encased duct banks, hand-holes, and various feeders, boxes and circuitry. The generator will be monitored by tying into the existing building automation system.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a cash deposit or a certified check drawn on some bank or trust company, insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, of an amount equal to not less than five percent (5%) of the proposal, or in lieu thereof a bidder may offer a bid bond of five percent (5%) of the bid executed by a surety company licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute the contract in accordance with the bid bond. Said deposit shall be retained by the owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten days after the award or to give satisfactory surety as required by law.

A performance bond and a payment bond will be required for one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price for all contracts.

Payment will be made based on ninety-five percent (95%) of monthly estimates and final payment made upon completion and acceptance of work.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of 60 days.
